NAPANc will provide financial support to promote professional development and educational development, for the International Collaboration of PeriAnesthesia Nurses (ICPAN) Biennial General Meeting(BGM) and Conference in 2019.

At the discretion of the NAPANc Executive Committee, a bursary for the maximum amount of C\$1000.00 will be awarded to a member using the following guidelines and requirements.

Application Process

Requirements

- Bursary recipient is required to write a NAPANc Newsletter Submission of 300-400 words in length. The submission should highlight the 2019 ICPAN Conference including all educational sessions attended and the value gained by attending the ICPAN Conference.
 - NAPANc Newsletter Submission must be submitted with original receipts by Dec. 6,
 2019 for funding.
- Must attend the Biennial General Meeting of the International Collaboration of PeriAnesthesia Nurses, 2019
- Applicants must be an active NAPAN© member for three (3) years prior to the application date.

Recognition will be based on a merit system (Page 4) including:

- Years of NAPAN© membership
- Current CNA Certification in PeriAnesthesia Nursing (200 points-see page 2)
- Active participation in the membership at chapter, jurisdiction or national/international levels.
 - Submit descriptive testimony of all the applicant's activities supporting active participation.

Application must be postmarked no later than June 30, 2019

Applicants must declare **alternate funds** applied for or received to attend the 2019 ICPAN BGM and Conference

- Alternate funds include but are not limited to the following: funding assistance with travel, accommodation and registration fees.

Original receipts must be submitted within 30 days following the close of the conference (Dec. 6, 2019). Successful applicant will be notified by the NAPANc executive.
