Laura Van Loon 2025 International Conference (ICPAN) Bursary

Objective:

One of The Charitable Objectives for which NAPANc is established:

• To advance education for PeriAnesthesia nurses across Canada through the provision of scholarships, bursaries, and other forms of financial assistance

NAPANc will provide financial support to promote professional development and educational development, for the International Collaboration of PeriAnesthesia Nurses (ICPAN) Biennial General Meeting (BGM) and Conference in 2025.

At the discretion of the NAPANc Executive Committee, a bursary for the maximum amount of CAD\$ 1000.00 will be awarded to a member using the following guidelines and requirements.

Application Process

Requirements

- Bursary recipient is required to write a NAPANc Website Submission of 300-400 words in length. The submission should highlight the 2025 ICPAN Conference including all educational sessions attended and the value gained by attending the ICPAN Conference.
- NAPANc Website Submission must be submitted with original receipts by September 10th, 2025 for funding.
- Must attend the Biennial General Meeting of the International Collaboration of PeriAnesthesia Nurses, 2025
- Applicants must be an active NAPAN[©] member for three (3) years prior to the application date.

Recognition will be based on a merit system (Page 4) including:

- Years of NAPANc membership
- Active participation in the membership at chapter, jurisdiction, or national/international levels.
 - Submit descriptive testimony of all the applicant's activities supporting active participation.

Guidelines:

- Application must be postmarked no later than May 30, 2025
- Applicants must declare **alternate funds** applied for or received to attend the 2025 ICPAN AGM and Conference
 - Alternate funds include but are not limited to the following: funding assistance with travel, accommodation and registration fees.
 - Not included are personal costs such as food, entertainment, tours, or telephone calls.

Original receipts must be submitted within 30 days following the close of the conference (September 5, 2025). Successful applicant will be notified by the NAPANc executive.

Include a 250-word paragraph anticipating "The Impact on how the opportunity to attend the 2025 International PeriAnesthesia Biennial Meeting and Conference will affect my participating in NAPANc" in the future. 100 points

- Chapter Executive Member: 30/year
- Chairperson of a Chapter Committee: 25/year
- Committee Member of a Chapter: 20/year

Jurisdictional

- Jurisdictional Executive Member: 40/year
- Chairperson of a Jurisdictional Committee: 35/year
- Committee Member of a Jurisdictional Committee: 30/year

National

- National Executive Member: 50/year
- Chairperson of National Committee: 40/year
- Committee Member of a National Committee: 35/years
- NAPANc Board member: 30/year
- International ICPAN Board/GAC/Committee: 30/year

Website Submission

- Submission and title of article to a PeriAnesthesia website in past 3 years: 30 points
- Submission and title of article to a PeriAnesthesia website in past 3-15 years: 20 points

Provide year and title of presentation as follows:

- Presenter at a PeriAnesthesia conference: 50 points/conference
- Poster Presenter at a PeriAnesthesia conference: 30 points/conference
