President's Address, October, 2009



Hello All PeriAnesthesia Nurses of Canada! And welcome to autumn....isn't it supposed to follow summer, though? I live in Ontario, and we had nothing resembling summer this year. But there has been snowfall already in many parts of Canada, including Ontario, so there is no more wishing for pleasant weather: winter is definitely on its way.

But enough about the weather: let's talk about really important topics, like what NAPANc is doing for you!

Certification for our area of specialty, PeriAnesthesia Nursing, is the hot topic these days, and there is much work to be completed! This project requires significant commitment and the work has already begun. The "Proposal Committee" (members of NAPANc) is busy developing the first proposal to be submitted to the Canadian Nurses Association (CNA) to apply for the privilege of being honored with our own Certification Examination. It is a significant commitment on the part of the CNA too, so they need to hear that we, as PeriAnesthesia Nurses, are serious about this exam.

The prerequisites for our Proposal being approved are a lengthy checklist of documentation and data collection. But here is where you can help:

We need 1,000 PeriAnesthesia Nurses from across Canada, to add their names to our list to signify their wish to write/take the Certification Examination. Don't hesitate to contact us if you have questions about this form. Encourage your colleagues to submit one too. Please let us hear from you, and soon! Our deadline is December, 2009!!

Also, we need to locate all PeriAnesthesia Nurses who are working as Advanced Practice Nurses (APN) in PeriAnesthesia environments: PACUs, Day Surgery Units, on Acute Pain Services, PreAdmission Units, as CNSs in these and related areas.
